Some academic improvisations that have been made in the session 2019 -2020 are:

There is a change in the Assessment pattern for classes III & IV. Term Exams have been introduced in Classes III & IV for 50 marks. EVS has been introduced in Class IV for the first time

An initiative has been taken to improve General Knowledge of the students of CLASSES III – VII and assessment of the same is being reflected in their report sheets.

The most important mission of the school is to keep the school and its surroundings clean and green.

This is being accomplished effectively by the Swachh Albans Committee which is involved in the segregation and disposal of waste in our school campus.

As always, in the current academic session 2019-2020 too, an orientation programme was conducted for the parents at the beginning of the new academic session for class Nursery to help in the better performance of their ward in their academic journey. Our Pre-Nursery teachers met all the parents for the same on a one to one basis.
