Innovations at St. Albans

St. Albans School continues to embrace innovative practices that enhance the educational environment and foster holistic development. During the academic session, the following initiatives were implemented:

• Buddy Teacher Concept

A new system was introduced where a designated "Buddy Teacher" steps in during the absence of the Class Teacher (CT) to manage responsibilities such as monitoring Zero Period/lunch, marking attendance, coordinating events like the Winter Carnival, and assisting with result compilation.

• Advanced Waste Segregation

In our ongoing efforts towards sustainability, waste segregation practices were expanded. In addition to dry, wet, and paper waste, plastic and metal waste were also collected separately, promoting responsible environmental practices among students.
