ASSESSMENT POLICY FOR CLASSES I – II

The session comprises two terms.

Term-I: April to September

Term-II: October to March

Each student will be assessed in **Scholastic** and **Co-scholastic** areas.

Scholastic: In this area, the ability of the child is assessed on the basis of all the curricular subjects including English, Hindi, Math, EVS and Computer.

Co-scholastic: For co-scholastic assessments, students' life skills, co-curricular activities, attitudes, values and interests, visual and performing arts and G.K. are judged thoroughly.

Scholastic Assessment:

1. Each semester will have two Unit Tests (20 Marks) per subject of 1 hour each.

- 2. General Knowledge will be assessed once in each term. There will be a written assessment of 20 marks and grades will be given on the basis of the marks obtained by the students.
- 3. The students will also be assessed on their personal and social traits i.e. Courteousness, Confidence, Care of belongings, Neatness and Uniform, Regularity and Punctuality, Initiative, Sharing and caring, Respect for others/school property and Self-control.
