

## ASSESSMENT POLICY FOR CLASSES III – V

### Session : 2021-22

The examination for the current academic year would be conducted according to the assessment structure explained below:

1. There will be two terms : Term I (April- September) and Term II (October- March).
2. The students will be assessed in the following areas: **Scholastic, Co- scholastic and Discipline.**

#### Scholastic Area :

- a) Students will be graded on an 8 point grading scale. (Refer to the table given below)
- b) Final Evaluation for each term will be on the basis of Term End Examination (50 marks) & Internal Assessment (50 marks).
- c) The break-up of **Internal Assessment** is as follows:
  - Unit Tests (20 marks )
  - Multiple Assessments (20 marks )
  - Oral (5 marks)
  - Subject Enrichment Activity (5 marks)

- **Unit Tests** will be conducted twice in a term. **Best of two Unit Tests** will be taken.
- Unit Tests will be conducted on a daily basis.

#### Co-Scholastic Area:

- i) Co- scholastic activities will be assessed on a 3 point grading scale. (Refer to the table given below).
- ii) Co-scholastic area will cover **Work Education / Art Education / Health and Physical Education and General Knowledge.**

iii) No upscaling of grade on the basis of these co-scholastic grades will be done.

- ❖ General Knowledge will be assessed once in each term. There will be a written assessment of 20 marks. Grades will be given on the basis of the marks obtained by the students

**Discipline :**

Students will also be graded for discipline on a 3 point grading scale considering the attendance, sincerity, behaviour and values.
